Academic Awards Night

Graduation Participation

It is the policy of Pierz Healy High School that a student must be on schedule to graduate as of the second Wednesday in May. All required and elective credits must be completed and/or scheduled to be completed **by May 14th**. Students not passing their courses in the 2nd semester must be within 2 credits of graduating to participate in the graduation ceremony. Any senior involved with vandalism, destruction of property, or egregious behavior risk participation in commencement.



Fines/Fees etc.

Seniors are required to pay any outstanding fees, etc. by May 19th. Seniors who do not pay their fines, outstanding fines/fees, or complete their assigned community service or consequences are not allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Please have your graduate verify with Tory In the high school office on the status of anything outstanding.

Graduation Practice (MAC gym)

Seniors who plan to participate in the graduation program on May 23rd <u>are required</u> to participate in this practice session. Students will be dismissed from second hour for a 10:30 pizza party in the Commons on Friday, May 23rd for an early Senior Lunch. Students will then have grad practice in the MAC.

Ticket Process

Each graduate will be given **ten tickets** to give to those they want in attendance. Your tickets will be sent out in mid-May. If your graduate will not be using all ten tickets, they can share them with other graduates that would like to have additional family in attendance. **All attendees must present a ticket** for admittance to the ceremony but will be able to sit in any unreserved seat within our MAC. The MAC doors will open at 6:00 p.m. for families. The ceremony will begin at 7:00 p.m.

Formal Pictures (Middle School Gym)

Graduates will have formal photos taken prior to the commencement on May 23rd in our Middle School Gym. More details will come about pictures and the evening of graduation.
